#### Action Items:

#### 1. Project Needs:

- Town wants to know, what can be done with the land, and what is feasible?
- Should the project be phased?
- Would like to provide the entire community with an improved network of trails (kids, adults, school, cross country/running, walking, dog walking, birding, fishing, school field trips, canoe access, cross country skiing)
- Want to utilize existing trails along the banks of Missisquoi River
- Educational signage in coordination with conservation commission
- Possible secondary connection on Intervale Ave by basketball courts to increase visibility – might need to clear brush & trees – might need staircase due to steep slope
- The 20-acre meadow is owned by the town and could provide a nice space for walking or a future fenced dog park
- Concerns about Route 105 crossing from school to Sewer Plant Rd
- Route 105 crossing might need a flashing light at the crossing
- Noted concerns about the elementary school being disconnected from downtown/playground – trail network provides opportunities for more connection
- A new sidewalk is planned from South Main St. to the school through a separate panning grant
- Possible connection / easement across land owned by Parsons
- Possible cross-country circuit need coordination with school/students/Mr. Marlow about width & distance might be a way to attract others outside of the community
